

History of KACF/CCM

1. ***Fall Quarter 1983***: Preliminary meetings at UCLA with Steve Chang, Burton Lee, Lynette Lee, and Ben Shin to discuss the possibility of forming an English-speaking Korean Bible Study.
2. ***Winter Quarter 1984***: Korean Christian Fellowship begins with 9 original members. Steve Chang gives the first message ever. Ben Shin leads praise and worship. Negative comments are made by the "other" Korean Bible Study accusing KCF of leaving behind the Korean culture.
3. ***Spring Quarter 1984***: 1st Senior Banquet for graduating seniors at a Chinese restaurant in K-Town.
4. ***Fall Quarter 1984***: KCF changes name to Korean American Christian Fellowship to highlight its Americanized identity.
5. ***Spring Quarter 1985***: 1st Spring Retreat for Korean American Christian Fellowship. The group begins to grow exponentially.
6. ***Fall Quarter 1985***: KACF explodes with 60-70 members at the first meeting.
7. ***Summer 1986***: 1st Summer KACF Meeting begins at John Kim's house.
8. ***Fall Quarter 1986***: KACF continues to grow in number and reaches close to 80-90 people.
9. ***Winter Quarter 1987***: KACF sponsors HIS Week at UCLA with Pastor John MacArthur speaking and Phil Keaggy in concert at Ackerman Grand Ballroom. KACCF enlists all the other campus ministries to join together.
10. ***Fall 1987 - Spring 1992***: Difficult times for the ministry which included lack of interest, commitment, and many other distractions. A positive note is that two Korean American churches' college groups begin to emerge during 1989-1991. L.A. Hanmi and Valley Community Church both begin to grow largely due to the attendance of many KACF members. Another factor is that Ben Shin and John Kim, both former leaders of KACF, become youth pastors at these two churches.
11. ***Fall 1989***: Meetings at L.A. Hanmi Church with John Park, David Park, Alice Cho, and Pastor Ben Shin to discuss the possibility of starting a KACF at UCSD. They all agree to start up the ministry the following Winter Quarter.
12. ***Winter 1990***: 1st meeting for KACF UCSD. Pastor Ben Shin speaks.
13. ***Spring 1990***: KACF Call State Fullerton starts up with a few students.
14. ***Fall 1991***: KACF UCSD explodes with 60 people at the 1st meeting for the year.

15. **Spring 1992 – Spring 1998:** KACF UCSD continues to grow exponentially and the ministry grows strong and stronger.
16. **Fall Quarter 1993:** Pastor Ray Chang asks Pastor Ben Shin to include and work with Korean Christian Fellowship of Irvine. Pastor Ben agrees and works with the ministry as an advisor until the Spring of 1997.
17. **Winter 1996:** 1st ever Founder's Day Banquet is held at the Castaway Restaurant in Burbank. Alumni and campus ministries are invited. 136 people attend the banquet.
18. **Spring 1996:** 1st Spring Advance with all of the KACF ministries at Arrowhead Springs. Pastors Steve Chang and Ben Shin are the speakers.
19. **Spring 1997:** KACF Call State Fullerton folds. Pastor Ben Shin steps down from the role of Director of KACF.
20. **Fall 1997:** Pastor David "Dok" Kim takes over as the Director of KACF.
21. **Summer 1998:** Shepherding School for training KACF members is held on September 4-5th at L.A. Hanmi Church.
22. **Fall 1998:** Pastor Ben Shin returns as Director of KACF. Serious talks are held by the Board of Directors to change the name of the ministry and to shift its focus to a more multi-ethnic target.
23. **Spring 1999:** Joint Rally is held at UCI to promote multi-cultural ministry. All the campuses attend. Pastor Tae Shin of Rock Foundation Church is the speaker.
24. **Summer 1999:** Summer Institute of Training begins as a 10 week training time during the summer for students. This time is used to help prep the students to change the ministries' name and vision.
25. **Fall 1999:** KACF officially changes their name to Crossroads Campus Ministries (CCM) in order to strategically reach more people on the campuses. All three campuses, UCLA, UCSD, and UCI adopt the new name and new vision of "pointing collegians to the cross." Campus ministers are appointed to each campus. Pastor Ryan Kwon serves at UCI, Pastor Chang Lee at UCLA, and Pastor Ben Shin at UCSD.
26. **Spring 2000:** CCM holds its first ever Spring Advance with all the campuses at the Oaks Christian Conference Center. Pastor David Gibbons from New Song Community Church is the speaker.
27. **Fall 2000:** CCM enters its second year with the new name. New advisors take over each campus. Pastor Roy Kim joins as the campus minister of UCI and Prof. Joe Lee becomes the campus minister of UCLA. UCSD goes without a campus minister.
